What is an SOP?

A short essay explaining the purpose of your application for your desired program at your chosen university.

What is the purpose of an SOP?

Demonstrate you have the academic strengths, motivation and career goals to be successful and add value to the university as a student and an alum.

What are SOP reviewers looking for?


- Academic potential to succeed
- Valuable & impactful career goals
- Alignment with their vision, mission & values
- Motivation & initiative
- Determination to overcome & learn from adversity
- Writing skills & attention to detail
- Ability to follow instructions
- Academic integrity

Show them you're making an informed decision

- Specific courses you want to take
- Specific faculty you're interested in working with
- ▶ Specific aspects of the program that excite you
- Specific features of the university that attract you
- ▶ How the program will support your career goals

Show them the value you will add

- Relevant technical skills you have gained from your academic or professional background
- Research you have conducted
- Your personal contribution to relevant projects
- ▶ Your professional or academic achievements
- Extracurricular activities that show key transferable skills, e.g.:
 - ▶ Leadership
 - ▶ Teamwork
 - ▶ Communication

Brainstorm some general ideas

- ▶ Why do you want to study at graduate level?
- Why are you applying to that particular program?
 - ▶ What courses or features of the program excite you the most?
- How will your professional and personal experiences add value to the program?
- What makes you special?
- ▶ How do you plan to use this degree?
 - ▶ How will this degree contribute to your career and life goals?

Write a concise one or two page statement of purpose (no less than 500 and no more than 1,000 words) in the following format. Your essay should begin "My objective in pursuing my program of choice is ...":

1. Briefly explain your objectives in pursuing a Master of Science degree:

- o What specific areas do you want to study at graduate school?
- Why are you interested in pursuing that particular area of study?
- · What do you plan to do with your degree once you graduate? Include your career goals and plans for your future.

2. Describe why you think you are a good candidate for this program at CMU-Africa:

- Provide information about your academic background and describe any significant academic projects.
- Provide information about any industrial or commercial work experience, including any research experience and publications.
- o Describe any relevant internships, research projects, personal projects or extracurricular activities.
- What will be the biggest challenge for you in graduate school? What strengths do you bring with you?

Before submitting, proofread your essay to make sure that you use appropriate grammar, and that your writing is clear.

PS: Please ensure that the content in your essay is your own or has been correctly referenced. Any form of plagiarism found in your are will be considered as a breach of the honor code you signed at the beginning of this application. Analyze the instructions

Develop an outline

Introduction

Explain your motivation for applying to grad school and how this relates to who you are and what you want to do in your career.

Second paragraph

- ▶ The reason(s) for your interest in this particular program.
- Your relevant professional goals.

Third paragraph

- Your relevant experience and accomplishments.
- ▶ The value you will add to the program & university.

Conclusion

A brief summary of your SOP that emphasizes your qualifications and good fit with the university.

What to avoid

- Failing to follow the instructions or address all parts of the prompt
- ▶ Typos and errors in punctuation, spelling or grammar
- ► An informal style
- Poor writing (unclear structure, lack of paragraphs, long sentences)
- ► Your life story or irrelevant information
- ▶ No concrete examples of your experience & achievements
- Telling them what they already know (e.g. a top-ranking university)
- Dishonesty or inauthenticity (writing what you think they want to read)
- Plagiarism
